
1. Recall a time when you were so very thankful that you paid attention to a warning.

an you recall a time when you were so thankful that you were saved from something because you paid attention to a warning? It's kind of fun to stop and think about all sorts of warnings. Road signs alert us to bumps on the road ahead, narrow roads, rough roads, curves, and multiple curves. Our phones warn us of unknown callers and spam, smoke detectors tweak when a battery is about to go out, and newer cars warn us when another car is in our blind spot. When we read our Bibles carefully, we realize that God warns His people of a great many threats on the road ahead. Our study today is a fresh reminder, "We've been warned" (1 Corinthians 4:14). Praise God!
