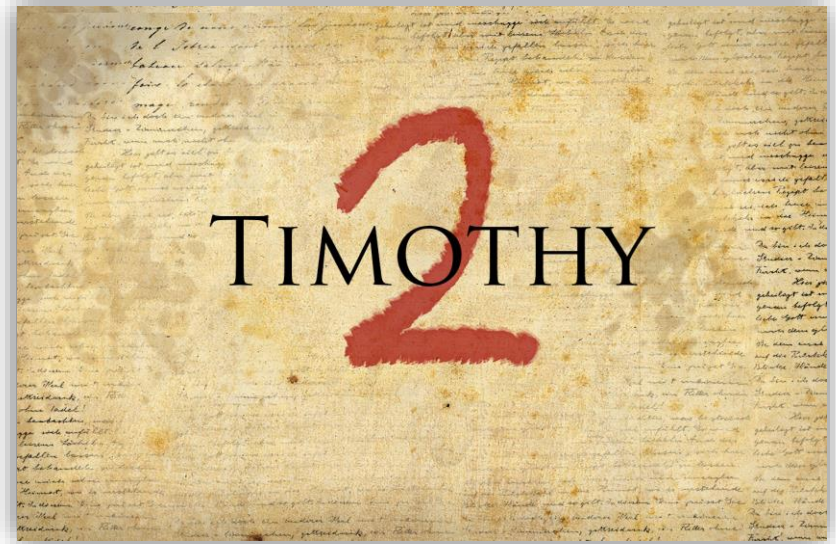


Personal Application and Conversations

It's a very effective children's ministry tool that comes from a serious challenge to Timothy and countless Christian workers like us over the past two thousand years. We know these verses and the challenge passed on to us. So, how accurately are we all handling the word of truth as we practice being workmen approved?

Keep reminding them of these things (v.14a)

Warn them before God against quarreling about words (v.14b)

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman...(v.15a)

Who does not need to be ashamed... (v.15b)

Handling accurately the word of truth (v.15c)
